As usual there are plenty of tasks that we need to get our teeth into at the forthcoming work session.

Where do frogs go in winter? Frogs, toads and reptiles hibernate for the cold months. A big home for these creatures is called a hibernaculum and your help is required with the construction of one beside the pond. If you have any large stones, bricks, drain pipes or logs in need of a good home bring them along on Sunday and all will be revealed.

- Complete pruning of the apple trees.
- Clean out nest boxes and re-site as necessary
- Mow the wild flower meadow area
- Sort out the bog garden
- Weed the south facing wild flower bank
- Dig over and remove roots from the new pollinator bed
- Create a hibernaculum beside the pond
- Compost making
- Trim the wildlife area hedges
- Remove goosegrass from the hedges
- Clear the shed site
- Dock removal
