Jubilee Green, Park Road: Call for volunteers to help manage this area.



The new fruit and deciduous trees need the grass and weeds round their base kept down until they are established.

This is best achieved by hand weeding. Any local residents who would like to contribute to this work are most welcome, and if you can just do a little bit when able, it would be greatly appreciated.

The long term plan is to establish wild flower patches here, but leaving space for picnics, etc. Yellow rattle was sown in the autumn of 2012 to help prepare the ground and some snowdrops were planted in February 2013.
